

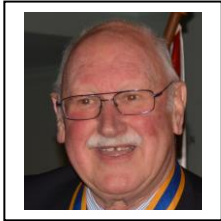

We are all hoping for fine weather for our Tunstall Square market on Sunday as it was not fun packing up in the heavy rain last market.

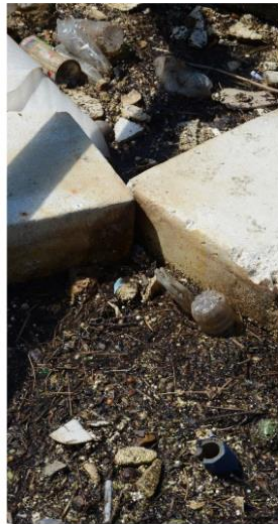

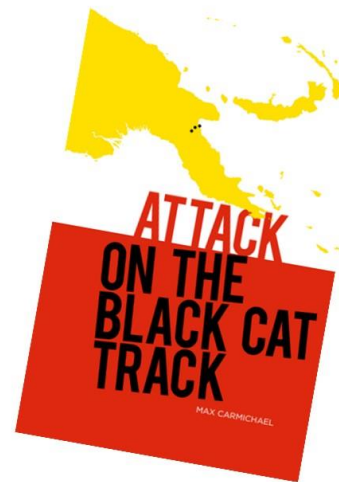
